Driving Directions: Follow the grand central parkway towards Manhattan/Triborough Bridge. Stay on the left and follow signs to the FDR Dr S. Exit onto 42nd St./United Nations. Follow 42nd St to 8th Ave. Turn right and go to 46th St. Turn right and the hotel will be on the right at the end of that block.
